

A CUBAN EDITOR SHOT.

An Affray Between Cubans at Key West—Castanon, Editor of a Havana Paper, Killed—The Feeling in Havana.

KEY WEST, Jan. 31.—GONZALO CASTANON, editor of the *Voz de Ouba*, while standing on the porch of his hotel, was attacked by several Cubans, who opened fire on him with pistols. He returned their fire, and had wounded three of his assailants, when he received a shot, from which he died in fifteen minutes. Several arrests have been made. The editors of the Key West *Dispatch*, in a card, withdrew an article which they published this morning, on the approaching duel, for the reason that the statements made are inaccurate.

HAVANA, Jan. 31.—The news of the shooting of Benor CASTANON at Key West causes great excitement here....The volunteers to-night arrested two men for using seditious language. It is reported that the prisoners attempted to escape, and were fired upon by their guard and killed. An investigation is now going on.
