Fate of Revolutionists—Business Outlook.

HAYANA, March 20.—Emiliano Nunez, who was taken prisoner at Sagua, when he tried to land there under the disguise of an American sailor, has been transferred to the Cabana Fortress, of this city.

Advices from Costa Rica report the death of General Manuel Quesada, who was one of the chief leaders of the late Cuban insurrection.

Reports from the Eastern provinces of the island show that agriculture and commerce are satisfactorily progressing, especially in the province of Puerto Principe, which is the reverse of the deplorable situation in several of the western provinces and the majority of the cities on the coast.

The house of Citias & Legima, of Sagua la Grande, has been declared bankrupt.

The Spanish Bank of Cuba has been appointed receiver of Caja de Ahorros (savings bank).
