

WILL REST IN NATIVE SOIL

General Francisco Agullera to be Buried in Cuba at His Own Request.

New York, Sept. 27.—In fulfilment of his dying wish, expressed more than 30 years ago, the body of Lieut. Gen. Francisco Vicente Agullera, hero of the Ten Year war in Cuba, will be disinterred from its resting place in Calvary cemetery here tomorrow and sent to his native land.

"When my country is free and takes her place among the nations of the earth then, and not till then, let my body be taken to Cuba for burial," was the prayer of Agullera on the day of his death, February 22, 1877.

A commission of leading Cubans, including the general's son, is here to superintend the removal of the body. It will be shipped to Tampa and there transferred to the Cuban gunboat Yara which will convey it to Habana.
