Death of a Prominent Cuban.
New York, February 24.—Major General Francisco Vicents Aquira, formerly Vice President of the Cuban insurrectionary government, died at his home in this city, yesterday afternoon.

His disease was cancer of the throat.

NEW YORK, February 25—The remains of Francisco Vincenti Aguilers, the dead Vice President of the Cuban Republic, lay in state all day to-day in the Governor's room in the City Hall.

The flags on the boilding were at half mast and the pillars leading to the room were draped in mourning. Thousands of people viewed the remains, among them prominent Cubans of the city. The guards of honor; composed of Cubans, relieved each other every hour. The

body will be taken to St. Francis Xavier church in the morning and the Mayor and Common Council will attend the funeral, as well as will numerous Cuban societies.
