

The Cuban Insurrection.

HAVANA, March 8.

The Spanish man-of-war Cadiz arrived here today from Spain with 1000 fresh troops.

Orders have been issued for the release of John M. Utley, Consular clerk in the American Consul General's office. Mr. Utley has been in prison for nearly a month, not for any political offence, but on account of some trouble with a coachman.

The American brig J. D. Lincoln, which was detained here for taking a cargo at Sierra Morena after that port was closed by Gen. Dulce's proclamation, finally obtained a clearance at the intercession of the American Consul.

An Insurgent General has been captured and taken to Sagua La Grande, where he is sentenced to be shot.
