

About Cuban Expeditions.

NEW YORK, May 8.

The World has the following special dispatch :

ST. LOUIS, May 7.

To-day Gen. Montgomery left for New Orleans to arrange for the transportation of a fighting expedition to Cuba, under Gen. Jos. Shelby. Montgomery was a Union General and Shelby a Confederate officer. They are working in concert, and can control 20,000 men.

NEW YORK, May 8.

General Jordan, who is said to be the great organizing officer of the old Confederate Army will not command the Cuban Army, but will merely perfect its organization, and the officer that is to command it went out disguised on Tuesday in the Arago as a private soldier, and that he did not discover himself to the men until the vessel had left the harbor. This officer is well known in the regular and volunteer armies, and is of first class capability.
