DINNER TO GENERAL DE RODAS—NEWS FROM THE SEAT OF WAR.

HAVANA, June 29.—Don Espinar, the late acting captain-general, gave a dinner yesterday in honor of General De Rodas. The latter made a speech, declaring that he came to the island counting on the aid of 50,000 volunteers in the suppression of the rebellion. Complete harmony exists between the new Captain-General and the volunteers. The Spanish admiral has returned from Cadiz. General Lesca is actively pursuing bands of insurgents in the **Cinco Villas** district, and has frequent encounters with them. The Diario says that he places the volunteer cavalry, composed of native Cubans, in the front ranks as defenders of the integrity of the Island. It is supposed that the insurgents executed the entire company of Spanish soldiers captured at Sabana Nuevo. The charred corpse of a Spanish officer was found in the ruins of one of the houses.
