HAVANA, 6.—On Thursday of last week the rebel General Orazo, was captured and brought to Sagua, and shot the following Saturday. The insurgents in the eastern department have concentrated their forces at Mayan. The troops left Santiago to attack them. A fight occurred between the colored volunteers and a band of colored insurgents in the neighborhood of Santiago. Seventeen of the latter reported killed. The Captain General has recognized Hall as Consul General from the United States. Arrests continue. Three hundred and fifty additional troops have arrived from Spain. It is believed that Derodas replaces Valmoseda in command of the troops and is not to relieve Dulce as Captain General. A revolutionary expedition is reported to have landed at the mouth of Sagua Grande. The inhabitants in the vicinity sunk the schooner on which they came to prevent the escape from the troops sent in pursuit.

HAVANA, 6.—Jose de Armas, who was recently sent as Commissioner by Dulce to the insurgents is alleged to have issued a proclamation at Nassau impugning the actions of Dulce. Corea, the companion of De Armas, denounces the proclamation as a forgery, and the statements therein, false. The revolutionist, General Queseda, is sick with small pox.
