WASHINGTON, 5.—Recent letters from San Juan De Las Remedios, Cuba, give the particulars of the massacre of Senora Arrelondo Seavel and her children. Her husband had joined the insurgents and she was enticed within the Spanish lines with her family under the pretence of meeting her husband, when the whole party were butchered by the infuriated

volunteers. Several pretended agents of Cubans, supposed to be Spanish emissaries, have been endeavoring to enlist various individuals without the authority or sanction of the Provisional government of Cuba or its representatives here.
