FROM NEW YORK. The Spanish Minister Sends the Secrecary of War an Ultimatum.—Reception at the White House. NEW YORK, May 6. A Washington special rays the Spanish Minister has informed the State Department that about this country recognize the beligerent rights of Cubans, Spain will regard It as a declaration of war and will authorize the fitting out of privateers which cannot fai: but do great harm. It proves that the "Arago" took no recraits for Caba. The schooner Grapeshol, which was reported sailed for Cuba with volunteers, is still here in this harbor.
