## FROM CUBA.

HAVANA, Feb. 24.

The naval expedition to La Guaraja was completely successful. The fortifications erected there by the insurgents were first bombarded by the fleet. The troops were then landed and the works were carried by assault. The rebels withdrew and retreated into the the country. A permanent garrison of regulars was left in command. On Sunday two battalions of troops marched from La Guaraja to the relief of Puerto Principe.

Captain General Dulce yesterday addressed the sergeants and corporals of the volunteer forces, exhorting them to maintain order and obedience and to discountenance all dangerous agitation.

A large number of rebel prisoners have been

brought to this city, and more are expected.

The sugar manufacturers demand relief from the burdens of taxation, and protection for their products, which, they complain, have decreased one-third.

The Prensa advocates the reestablishment of

export duties.
