Arrival of Spanish Troops at Havana and Cienfuegos.

HAVANA, Oct. 18.—Three steamers have reached Cuba within forty-eight hours, all bringing reinforcements for the Spanish army. The Spanish mail steamer, previously reported, arrived Sunday. A steam transport, direct from Cadiz, touched at Cienfuegos yesterday, and landed 1,000 men. Another steamer arrived in the harbor here this morning full of troops. The General Transatlantic Company's steamer *Louisiana* arrived from Vera Cruz to-day, and sailed for St. Nazaire this afternoon. The steamer *Oleopatra* arrived from New-York, and sailed this afternoon for Vera Cruz.
