
CUBA AND SPAIN.

The Cuban Insurgents the Instigators of the Spanish Outbreak—Rebels Seeking Pardon.

HAVANA, Oct. 19.—The *Diario de la Marina* to-day publishes three important documents, intercepted in their passage through the island, which, if true, prove that the Republican rising in Spain is the work of the Cuban insurgents. An additional detachment of troops was to-day sent to the seat of war. Twenty rebels have presented themselves to the Spanish authorities at Cienfuegos and asked for pardon. The steamer *Morro Castle* arrived here at noon to-day.

MADRID, Oct. 19.—The *Opinion* says an understanding exists between the insurgents here and in Cuba. The Cubans are to assist the Republicans in Spain with money, and when the Republic is established the independence of Cuba will be recognized.
