CUBA AND SPAIN.

The Cubau Insurgents the Instigators of the Spanish Outbreak-Rebels Seeking Pardon.

HAVANA, Oct. 19.—The Diario de la Marina to-day publishes three important documents, intercopted in their passage through the island, which, if true, prove that the Republican rising in Spain is the work of the Cuban insurgents. An additional detachment of troops was to-day to the seat of war. Twenty rebels have presented themselves to the Spanish authorities at Cienfuegos and asked for pardon. The steamer Morro Casile arrived here at noon to-day.

Madrin, Oct. 19.—The Opinion says an understanding exists between the insurgents here and in Cuba. The Cubans are to assist the Republicans in Spain with money, and when the Republic is established the independence of Cuba will be recognized.
