

CUBA.

Havana dispatches report small bodies of rebels near Trinidad, and skirmishes in the Cuatro Villas and Sierras Nuevas districts; Cuban loss in the former six, in the latter seven; Spanish loss not reported.

The *London Standard* of yesterday, in referring to the position of the United States in the case of the *Cuba*, says: "The basis on which the case of the *Alabama* rests is that she was not such a vessel as the *Cuba*," and adds that England could not so have proceeded against her.

The trial of the officers of the *Cuba* was continued at Wilmington, N. C., yesterday. Detective Officer GORDON was the only witness thus far examined, and it is said the defence expect to invalidate his testimony. The men of the *Cuba* are still in the city; they are reported as orderly and manifesting no disposition to leave.
