A Belligerent Editor in Havana—A Challenge from the Editor of the "Voz" to the Editor of the "Prensa."

HAVANA, Oct. 27.—The steamship *Columbia*, from New-York 21st inst., arrived here this morning.

Señor CASTANON, editor of the *Voz de Cuba*, yesterday challenged Señor GILPI, editor of the *Prensa*. GILPI has refused to fight.

The Case of the Cuban Privateer at Wilmington—Witnesses for the Defence Examined.

WILMINGTON, Oct. 27.—The trial of the officers of the *Cuba* was resumed before the United States Commissioner this morning. JAS. DENNISON, one of the engineers; DAVIS, one of the marines of the *Cuba*, and Captain MAFFETT and Captain BOLLES, both old naval officers, were examined for the defence. The testimony was very favorable to the defendants, and greatly weakened the evidence of GORDON, the principal witness for the Government. DAVIS testified that he had been offered \$20 to give evidence against the ship. The impression is very general now that the officers will be discharged.
