## An Investigation Demanded by the Officers of the Cuba.

It was rumored, yesterday, that Commodore Higgins and the officers of the Cuba, or Hornel, made a visit to the headquarters of the Cuban Junta for the purpose of demanding an investigation into the charges recently made against them through the Press. It is alleged that the charges originated among the members of the Junta, but the latter emphatically deny the accusation. It is understood, however, that they have refused to make an investigation, although they have requested time to consider the report made by Commodore Higgins in regard to the necessity which compelled him to run his vessel into the mouth of Cape Fear River. It is also said that the officers of the Cuba feel very indignant at the ungenerous treatment which they have received at the hands of the Junta since their return from Wilmington.
