Chinamen Burning Cane Fields—A Settlement Captured by Insurgents—Attempt to Capture a Spanish Train.

HAVANA, Nov. 14.—On Thursday last seven cane fields in the vicinity of Las Cruces were burnt. Since that time four Chinamen were discovered in the act of firing another cane field. They were seized and immediately executed. The settlement of Taguayaben, which was defended by thirty volunteers, has been captured by the insurgents and burnt. The insurgents were defeated while attempting to capture a railroad train. Troops have been sent to Taguayaben from Remedios. The cholera still prevails in the jurisdiction of Remedios. The steamship *Bavaria*, from Hamburg for New-Orleans, arrived to-day.
