

SPAIN.

The Bishop of Havana—The Complicity of Republicans with the Cubans—Candidates for the Throne,

MADRID, Nov. 23.—The Bishop of Havana, who was recently arrested at Cadiz, was brought to this city to-day under guard. He will have an examination immediately.

In compliance with a resolution adopted by the Cortes calling for information, the Government has been obliged to submit for examination documents which implicate Spanish republicans in a conspiracy with the insurgents of Cuba. The journals here contradict the report which had gained some credit outside of Spain, that in many political circles the Duke of Aosta was preferred to the Duke of GENOA for the throne.
