## CUBA.

Steamers Arrived—Admiral Poor Visits the Captain-General—A Tour of Inspection—The Rate of Discount.

HAVANA, Nov. 3.—The steamships Eagle, from New-York, and Yazoo, from Philadelphia, have arrived here, the former last evening, and the latter this morning.

Admiral Poor, United States Navy, accompanied by American Consul Plumb, have exchanged visits with Captain-General DE RODAS.

Captain-General DE RODAS will leave Havana to-night on a tour of inspection. During his journey he will visit Cienfuegos and other parts of the island. The Captain-General will be accompanied by his Secretary and staff, and will probably be absent about ten days.

The rate of discount of the Spanish Bank has been reduced to four per cent. The confidence of the merchants of Havana in the stability of the bank is continually increasing.

The steamer De Soto sailed this afternoon for New-York.
