

Smuggling Cigars.

An examination was held before United States Commissioner SHIELDS, yesterday, in the case of J. H. SCHROEDER and ISIDORE M. BON, jointly charged with complicity in smuggling cigars into this port. Testimony was given by JOHN A. ALLARAU to the effect that he smuggled about 20,000 unstamped Havana cigars into this City, and that he kept them concealed at the corner of Nassau and Fulton streets for some time, finally disposing of them to the defendants below the market prices. The case was subsequently adjourned.
