## Another Cuban Expedition.

Intelligence received at a late hour last night from a reliable source reached us of the enlisting of another Cuban expedition being now in progress in this City, Philadelphia and Baitimore. We cannot say, as yet, whether the expedition is being formed under the auspices of the Cuban Junta or not, but presume that with their recent ignoble failures staring them in the face, such is not the case. We also learn that one or two very fast steamers have been purchased, by parties unknown, and will at an early date, if not stopped, attempt to pursue a course similar to that marked out for the illfated Cuban steamer Ouba. (Hornet.)

General Golcuria, the unfortunate commander of the Ryan and Lillian Cuban expeditions, is expected to arrive in this City to-day, he having been released from the custody of the Nassau

British officials.
