SPAIN.

Constitutional Guarantees—A Carlista Chief to be Executed—The Troops Sent to Cuba.

Madrid, Dec. 4.—The constitutional guarantees, which were suspended/some time ago as a measure of public safety, have been restored.

MADRID, Dec. 5.—The Carlist Chief Polo has been convicted of treason and sentenced to death. Rumors of a Carlist insurrection continue to circulate. In the Cortes, yesterday, General Prim stated that since the commencement of the Cuban rebellion fourteen vessels-of-war, including two iron-clads, had sailed for Cuba, transporting nearly 40,000 troops.
