A New Battalion of Volunteers—Spanish Reports of Recent Successes.

HAVANA, Sept. 9.—General Lesca left the city at noon to-day for Sagua, with the new battalion of volunteers, four hundred strong.

A detachment of two hundred Spaniards met the insurgents in Sevilla Bay and put them to flight.

In a skirmish near Ramon thirty rebels are reported to have been killed.
