Late news from Havana states that thirty insurgents had been killed in skirmishes with Major LA CASA, near Anyo Blanco, in the jurisdiction of the Cuatro. Volunteering for the reserve corps of Havana was being promoted by committees in that city, and money had been subscribed to purchase Remington rifles for the Catalan volunteers. Four thousand troops will soon leave Madrid for Cuba.

Advices from Puerto Principe state that the insurgents lost ten men in recent attacks on the Spanish forces at San Serapio, and finally retreated.
