Rebel Arms and Ammunition Captured—An Insurgent Leader Executed—Arrest of Conspirators.

HAVANA, Dec. 24, 1869.

A quantity of arms and ammunition, intended for shipment to the insurgent forces, was found yesterday on the plantation of Tello Lamar, near Matanzas. The commander of the Spanish forces immediately assembled a court martial, which tried Lamar and found him guilty of treason. Lamar was executed to-day.

Miguel Acosta, one of the leaders of the insurgents, has been executed.

A large number of Cubans, who have been arrested for conspiracy against the Spanish government and for other offences, were to-day sent to Spain by order of Captain General De Rodas.
