

THE CUBAN REVOLUTION.

Arrival of an Envoy from the Provisional Government.

Señor Morales Lemus arrived in this city yesterday as Minister from the provisional government of Cuba. Señor Lemus is fully empowered to treat with the government of the United States for a full recognition of the revolutionary government of the Queen of the Antilles, and bears a commission to that effect from President Cespedes, who is now in command of the revolutionary forces. His stay in this city will be necessarily brief, as it is his intention to proceed at once to Washington to lay before President Grant and his Cabinet the despatches he bears and urge a speedy consummation of the object of his mission.
