CUBA. Mr. Codrington Released-The Havena Police to be Remodelled-Arrest of Two Cubans on Board an American Vessel. HAVANA, March 20, 1860. Mr. Codrington, the United States Consular agent

at Gibara, who was recently brought here in frons on suspicion of being a rebel spy, was released today at the intercession of Acting Consul General Hall The government is remodelling the police system of Havana. The office of chief of poice has been abolished, and the Covernor of the city will perform the duties of that position. The control of the police is to be placed entirely in the hands of the civil au-

thorities. It is expected that a great saving will be made in the expenditures of the government by this
