Arrival of a Steamer from Nuevitas at Havana with Wounded Soldiers—Nothing reliable about the Filibusters.

HAVANA, MAY 30, 1869.

The Spanish steamer Pelago arrived to-day from Nuevitas. She brings no reliable news. The reports as to the movements of the filibusters are conflicting and worthless, consisting of extreme statements made by both parties.

The Pelago brings a number of wounded soldiers and a cannon captured from the filibusters in the Bay of Nipe.
