The Spanish General Puella, who has arrived at Havrana, says it will require 5,000 additional troops to enable the government to retain possession of the Cinco Villas. The schooner La Have has been released, and is being towed to Jamaica by her captors. Another filbustering expedition has landed

on the south side of the island. Another engagement recently took place at a point between Puerto Padre and Las Lunas, in which General Ferrer, with 800 troops, was defeated by the Cubans, and compelled to retreat to Las Lunas, losing his convoy. The volunteers, in order to convince the home government that they have no idea of opposing the new Captain General, Rodas, have given up the duty of garrisoning Morro Castle and Fortress Cubanas, and

will to-day be relieved by a naval force.
