**The American Flag Hoisted near Matanzas—Arrival of Ammunition—Peruvian Monitors in the service of the Revolutionists—A British Vessel Seized.**

**NEW YORK, March 31.**—A Matanzas letter states that a body of Cuban patriots near there have raised the American flag, and that a large expedition with arms, ammunition, etc., has safely landed at Cochinos.

**NEW YORK, March 31.**—The *Herald* special from Key West, of the 31st, says: Information from the most reliable sources has been received here that the so-called Peruvian monitors are really in the service of the Cuban revolutionists, and it is believed they are now in the vicinity of Manzanilla.

**HAVANA, March 30, via KEY WEST, March 31.**—The British Consul has sent the gunboat *Huron* to the Caribbean, where the British ship *Jeff Davis* was captured by a Spanish cruiser. Volunteers at Caribbean seized two Cuban passengers, as they landed from the *Jeff Davis*, and immediately shot them. The captain and crew have been thrown into jail. The British Consul expected to have the British fleet soon cruising in the Bahamas. Two steamers and two schooners have landed men and arms at Cape Maze, the extreme eastern point of the Island.
