

## THE CUBAN INSURRECTION.

The agents of the Cuban Revolutionary Junta are making the most persistent efforts to secure a recognition of the insurgents as belligerents by the United States. They have had several interviews with the Secretary of State in reference to it within the last few days,—but there is the best authority for the statement that our Government will take no action whatever on the subject, at least for the present.—The Cubans have the sympathy of the President and the entire Cabinet, but it is felt that the rebellion is not one of the proportions and strength to justify the important concession demanded.
