Arrival of Mr. Seward at Havana—A Week's Sojourn Contemplated.

HAVANA, Jan. 17.—The steamships *Cleopatra* and *France* have arrived here from Vera Cruz. Among the passengers by the former were Secretary SEWARD and his party. They are all well. They will probably remain a week or so in Havana.

The Spanish Fleet at Charleston.

CHARLESTON, S. C., Jan. 17.—A fleet of thirteen Spanish gunboats, under convoy of the frigate *Isabel la Catolica*, from New-York via Hampton Roads, put into this harbor to-day for coal and supplies. They expect to remain here about ten days, when they will leave for Cuba.
