An Ex-Rovernor of Ravana Banished— An Mayana Editor in Florida to Fight a Buel.

HAVANA, Jan. 29.—GUTIERREZ VEGA, ex-Governor of Havana, has been banished from the Island of Cuba by order of Marshal Serrano.

KEY WEST, Fla., Jan. 29.—GONZALO CASTU-NON, the editor of the Voz de Cuba, in company with four Spaniards, arrived here this morning from Havana, for the purpose of lighting a duel with the editor of the Key West Republican. Meeting at the hotel, a violent altereation took place between the two editors. Castunon was arrested and placed under bonds to the amount of \$200, gold, to keep the peace. The Cubans in this city are excited and threatening. Guards from the barracks have been stationed about the streets to preserve order. Both parties are determined.
