CUBA.

Captain-General De Rodas' Latest Executive Act—Liberation of Four Thousand Government Slaves—Mora and Parodi—Matanzas—Capture of a Cuban Admiral.

HAVANA, Dec. 5.—Captain-General DE RODAS will leave the island on the 15th. He liberated the remaining 4,000 negroes (*emancipados*) today, leaving no blacks on which the Government has claim. These are now all free. The Cardenas volunteers have brought to Havana, by order of DE RODAS, the Cuban prisoners MORA and PARODI, whose case excited so much comment here and in Spain last year. They have been placed in charge of the proper authorities here. The Regent has granted to the City of Matanzas the distinction of "Very loyal and noble." The Spanish Capt. ALFARO, a native of San Domingo, has captured the so-called Cuban Admiral MUNOZ and five others in the rear of Santiago de Cuba.
