Indictments Against Cuban Filibusters.

Considerable excitement was caused at the United States Circuit Court, yesterday, on the entrance of the Grand Jury with three or four important indictments, which were presented to Judge Woodruff. It was reported that the indictments were found against persons engaged in fitting out an expedition to Cuba, but the Government officials preserved the closest silence in regard to the accused parties, or the nature of their offense. Bench warrants were issued for the arrest of the indicted persons. and Deputy Marshals Kennedy and Robinson were detailed to find the offenders. They scoured the City, last evening, in company with the private detective known as the "Spanish spy." but they were unable to apprehend the accused.
