

Mr. Seward in Cuba—Reception at Cardenas.

HAVANA, Feb. 9.—HON. WILLIAM H. SEWARD, accompanied by his son and two ladies, arrived at Cardenas on the 28th ult., from Matanzas. The party was met at the depot by a deputation of the volunteer officers of Cardenas, who escorted them to the hotel. About noon the American residents of the place went *en masse* to pay their respects to the distinguished visitor, to whom they were severally introduced by Mr. Cross, the United States Vice-Consul. The traveling party left Cardenas at 3 P. M., in a special train for a neighboring plantation. The greatest respect and attention was shown them by the civil and military authorities, many of whom urged Mr. SEWARD to remain a couple of days in Cardenas on his return.
