The Feeling Over the Killing of Castanon

-Another Version of the Affair-Castanon the Agressor.

HAVANA, Feb. 2.—The funeral of Castanon took place at noon to-day. The procession which followed the remains to the grave occupied two hours in passing a given point, and is considered the largest of the kind over seen in this city. Captain-General DE Rodas announces in a publie order to-day that he will take the children of the deceased under his special protection. The assassination of Castanon continues to be the general topic of discussion....At Matanzas, last night, the volunteers, excited by the Castanon affair, assembled in the square in front of the Governor's Palace and called for ACEVEDO and HERNANDEZ, who were imprisoned having concealed arms in their houses. volunteers made loud threats The and muaketa their in fired the air. Tho Governor came forward and made a tranquilizing speech, but firmly refused to deliver up the prisoners. The volunteers lingered in the plaza until morning, when they dispersed without doing further mischief .... The steamer Morro Castle, from New-York, arrived this morning.

New-Orleans, Feb. 2.—Dr. Hoda, a prominent Cuban, telegraphed to Key West to ascertain if it was true that Castanon, editor of the Voz de Cuba, had been cowardly assassinated by Cubans, as reported, and received the follow-
