The Sale of the Island–Mass-Meeting in Havana–A Cuban League Formed in Boston.

HAVANA, March 24.—A mass-meeting was held last night, which was called for the purpose of taking some action on the position lately assumed in regard to Cuba by a portion of the Madrid Press. About 1,500 Spaniards and many Cubans were present. Resolutions were adopted protesting against any policy which involves the sale of the Island of Cuba to the United States.
