Reported Successful Landing of Fillibusters—Mard Fighting—The Cholera. HAVANA, March 22, via KEY WEST, March 25.-Advices from Nuevitas to the 20th inst., report that filliblusters had effected a landing near Nucvas Graudes. Troops were telegraphed for from Puerto Principe. They arrived at Nuevitas on the 19th, and immediately started in pursuit of the rebels. Two gun boats had also sailed for Nuevas Grandes, to cut off retreat by sea.... Hard fighting was reported near Manati, No details had been received. The troops must have lost heavily, as the Hpanlards at Nuevitas seemed much depressed There are many cases of cholora at San Miguel and Baga.
