### **Reported Successful Landing of Filibusters—Hard Fighting—The Cholera.**

HAVANA, March 22, via KEY WEST, March 25.—Advices from Nuevitas to the 20th inst., report that filibusters had effected a landing near Nuevas Grandes. Troops were telegraphed for from Puerto Principe. They arrived at Nuevitas on the 19th, and immediately started in pursuit of the rebels. Two gunboats had also sailed for Nuevas Grandes, to cut off retreat by sea.... Hard fighting was reported near Manati. No details had been received. The troops must have lost heavily, as the Spaniards at Nuevitas seemed much depressed.....There are many cases of cholera at San Miguel and Baga.

CHARLESTON, S. C., March 25.—The Cuban Junta of this city have determined to hold, on the 5th of April, a public meeting of the Charleston sympathizers with the independence of Cuba, to co-operate with the Cuban League of New-York.
