## Scizure of a Steamer at Nassau-Cuban Refugees at Baltimore.

BALTIMORE, Md., March 27.-The schooner Gertic Lewis arrived at this port last evening, from Nassan. She reports that the steamer Salvador was seized by the authorities of Nassau for a breach of the Passenger act, and had been condomned, sold, and bought by the Government authorities for one hundred pounds. The Spanish gun-boat Conde de Venedito was ashore to the northward of Nassau, but succeeded in getting off with some damage. The Lewis brought five Cubans of the ill-fated Lillian expedition consigned to the Cuban Junta at New-York.
