

Seizure of a Steamer at Nassau—Cuban Refugees at Baltimore.

BALTIMORE, Md., March 27.—The schooner *Gertie Lewis* arrived at this port last evening, from Nassau. She reports that the steamer *Salvador* was seized by the authorities of Nassau for a breach of the Passenger act, and had been condemned, sold, and bought by the Government authorities for one hundred pounds. The Spanish gun-boat *Conde de Venedito* was ashore to the northward of Nassau, but succeeded in getting off with some damage. The *Lewis* brought five Cubans of the ill-fated *Lillian* expedition consigned to the Cuban Junta at New-York.
