
THE WEST INDIES.

A Discussion on Lersundi in Cuba—Removal of Puelle-Tonnage Dues in Jamaica.

HAVANA, March 31.—The *Voz de Cuba* published a bitter article against LERSUNDI, whereupon the *Prensa*, which was about to unite with the *Voz*, denounces it, and declares it cannot join a journal which attacks such a patriot as LERSUNDI. The *Diario* also defends LERSUNDI, repelling the idea that he ever had any connection with a plan to erect Cuba into a Province independent or opposed to the present Government. Rebels continue to surrender themselves in the Central Department. Skirmishes are reported near Nuevitas. Gen. ARANGO has issued a manifesto to the people declaring that the revolution has no reason to exist today, and advising his countrymen to lay down their arms. Gen. PUELLO has been relieved of his command. His successor has not yet been announced.
