

Another Spanish Victory—One Hundred and Seventy Insurgents Killed—No Details.

HAVANA, April 18.—The Captain-General telegraphs from Puerto Principe that the insurgent forces under the command of MAXIMO GOMEZ and MODESTO DIAZ made an attempt to pass the lines of VALMASEDA's division at Cauto Abajo, with the object of invading the jurisdiction of Bayamo. They were met by two Spanish battalions, and repulsed, with the loss of 170 killed. The rebels fled in great confusion, and at last accounts were utterly disorganized. The dispatch of the Captain-General gives no further particulars.
