Insurgent Successes in the Bayamo District and at Other Points—Operations at Canto Abajo.

HAVANA, April 20.—Gen. Valmaseda has issued two proclamations announcing the entrance of the insurgent forces, commanded by Madesto Diaz, in the Bayamo trict, after a fight. The Canto Abajo insurgents attacked, captured and burnt Capitama del Horno, after a severe engagement, during which thirty-five volunteers and forty insurgents are reported to have been killed. The Spanish wounded escaped miraculously. Six Spanish battalions are pursuing the insurgents to prevent them entering the Sierra. Another body of insurgents are operating this side of Canto.

The amount subscribed by citizens of Havana and other cities for the family of the late ISAAC GREENWALDT, the American who was murdered by a Spaniard in this city, has reached the sum of \$6,500.
