
An Expedition on the Way to Cuba.

Saturday morning, between the hours of 2 and 9 A. M., an expedition sailed for Cuba under the command of Col. CRISTO. The expedition numbered 300 men, all Cubans, with the exception of five American Captains. They carried with them 7,000 rifles, consisting of Remington, Winchester and Enfield, 1,000 muskets, 200 revolvers, 100 axes, a battery of six large guns, uniforms, equipments, and about two tons of powder. They sailed on board a steamer going to San Domingo as regular passengers, where Gen. WILLIAMS is waiting for them.
