Gen. Jordan in Washington—Interest in the Cuban Cause—The Cuban Coast Watched for Filibusters.

WASHINGTON, May 26.—Gen. JORDAN was at the House this afternoon, in conference, from time to time, with individual members known as friends of Cuban independence. He recently had an interview with President GRANT, representing to him the resources of the insurgents and their prospects of success. Last night he dined with Representative SWANN, there being present nearly all the members of the Committee on Foreign Affairs. Gen. JORDAN expresses himself much pleased with the progress he has made since his arrival in Washington in securing a more friendly interest in behalf of the cause, especially among the members of Congress.

HAVANA, May 26.—The steam-ship *Columbia*, from New-York May 19, arrived this morning. The Spanish vessels are watching the Cuban coast closely to intercept filibusters.
