

Aiding the Cubans—A Repentant Patriot.

In the Superior Court, Special Term, before Judge McCUNN, yesterday, a hearing was had on a motion in the case of ENRIQUE LOYNES vs. MANUEL QUESADA, to compel the defendant to give security for costs, as a non-resident. It appears that about the time of the breaking out of the revolution in Cuba, the plaintiff gave to defendant at Nassau, N. P., \$1,500 for the Cuban cause. Subsequently, plaintiff repenting of his generosity, requested the return of his money, which was refused. He therefore commenced this action to recover the amount. Beside a general denial, the defendant sets up that in receiving the money, he merely acted as the agent of the Republic of Cuba, and cannot therefore be sued personally. The Court made an order directing defendant to file the necessary bond for costs.
