### Rearrest of Foreign Freemasons—A Cuban Fort Captured—Correspondence Seized—Death of the Cuban Minister of War.

HAVANA, June 13.—The Police have arrested a number of foreign residents who attended a meeting of a Masonic lodge here three months ago. It will be remembered that the law forbidding the meeting of secret societies was put in force at that time, that a meeting of a Masonic lodge was broken up and all attending it were thrown into jail, but the foreign members were subsequently released by order of the Captain-General. The reasons for the rearrest of the latter so long after the event, are unknown. Dispatches from the Captain-General's head-quarters at Puerto Principe, report that Col. MONTANER has captured a rebel fort on Maximo River and killed eighteen of the enemy. The detachment under Col. VERGEL shot several rebels, and among them their leader, LABORDA. Capt. CHICLANA, in command of a party of loyal guerrillas, reports eighteen rebels killed and sixteen taken prisoners in the San Miguel Mountains. The Spanish gun-boat *Neptune* has captured important correspondence addressed to CESPEDES and other rebel officers. The Spanish steamer *Vigia*, off Cayo Guajaba, captured five boats filled with families of the insurgents. Señor LERDA, rebel Minister of War, died recently of fever.
